I, Tonia Dickerson, hereby certify: That I am the Manager of Sentence Administration, Offender Records, and Registries for the Oklahoma Department of Corrections, the agency having jurisdiction over all adult correctional facilities of the State of Oklahoma; that I am the departmental authority in matters of time calculation, sentence interpretation, and offender release dates; that the following is a true and correct statement concerning Christopher O. Jordan ODOC #407943.


On October 12, 2001, Christopher O. Jordan DOC #407943 was sentenced in Oklahoma County on CF-1999-4373 count 1 Murder in the First Degree to a 30 year incarceration sentence with Life suspended and count 3 Conspiracy to Commit a Felony to 10 year incarceration running concurrent with each other. He was received in the Oklahoma Department of Corrections on October 24, 2001 with a beginning days to serve of 10,957 (30 years) minus 815 days spent in the county jail.

State Statute 57 OS 138(A) states in part, "No deductions shall be credited to any inmate serving a sentence of life imprisonment; however, a complete record of the inmate's participation in work, school, vocational training, or other approved program shall be maintained by the Department for consideration by the paroling authority."

Mr. Jordan received a 30 year incarceration sentence with Life suspended (split life sentence) and began earning credits at reception. In 2003, then Sentence Administration Manager, Jim Rabon instructed per DOC interpretation of statute the earned credits would be posted but would not reduce the length of the sentence. Therefore, 714 earned credits were removed September 2003.

On November 1, 2014, ODOC operations procedure OP 060211 "Sentence Administration" was revised to clarify when an inmate is sentenced to life suspended except for a term of incarceration (split life sentence), the term of incarceration shall not be subject to subsection A of 57 OS 138. Mr. Jordan's file was audited and he had accumulated enough earned credits (5342 earned credits) to complete his 30 year incarceration sentence and was released on December 5, 2014 to begin serving the Life suspended portion of his sentence.
